Cheques should be made payable to **Kent Woodturners**. Please note that your subscription covers Kent Woodturners and the national body, the AWGB. No further subscription is payable to AWGB.

The subscriptions are:

- £46.00 for individual members;
- £68.00 for family membership – all applicants to sign to accept ;
- £10.00 for junior membership, applicable to individuals under 21 years of age on the date of joining and subsequent renewal dates. Junior members under 16 years of age should arrange for this form to be countersigned by a parent/guardian to acknowledge that personal data is held as disclosed below under our Data Privacy Policy.

If Membership commences after 30th June, subscriptions are as follows: £23.50 for individual members; £34.00 for family membership; £5.00 for junior membership.

If membership commences after 1st October in any year, you pay the annual subscription due for the following year but receive membership operative from the date of joining until 31st December the following year.
